Salvatore Patti is Professor of Private Law (Ordinario di Diritto Privato) at University of Rome I "La Sapienza" and has taught at the University Bocconi in Milan and other European Universities.

He studied at the University of Catania, where he graduated magna cum laude. He is a lawyer and admitted at the Italian Supreme Court ("Corte di Cassazione").
