

Biography Professor Jacques Sluysmans

Prof Sluysmans has been a legal practitioner since 1999. Currently he is a partner at Van der Feltz, a law firm in The Hague that he co-founded in 2006. He completed his doctoral thesis entitled “The continuing viability of compensation law in expropriation cases” in 2011 at Leiden University. It concerns the question whether the Dutch Expropriation Act of 1851 is still able to adequately govern modern instances of expropriation, especially as to the way in which compensation should be calculated. In 2013 he was appointed professor of Expropriation law at Radboud University Nijmegen. He is chairman of the Dutch Association for Expropriation Law and adviser to several Dutch courts in matters regarding compensation for expropriation
